Where To Sell

Sell popcorn outside storefronts - Once the order form is filled out, set up a table outside the business and sell popcorn. This is a good way to sell remaining products after the event.

Have mom and dad sell at work - Mom and dad can help out too by taking an order form to work. Their co-workers can fill out the order form with their orders, and in several weeks, mom/dad will collect the money and deliver the products.
