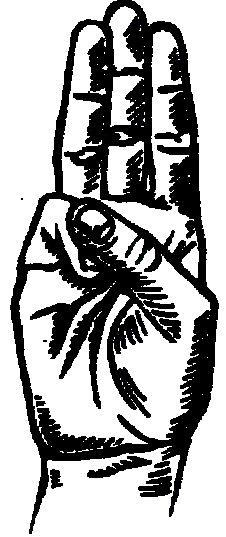
Friends of Scouting
