

# Spookoree I I

Due to the popularity of the Cub Scout Spookoree last October, Spookoree II is planned for the weekend of October 16 - 18 at Rhodes France Scout Reservation south of Pana. Cub Scouts and their families are invited to come and attend this exciting family fall festival and campout weekend. This year's events will include model rocket building and launching, hayride camp tour with a mystery destination, crafts, scavenger hunt, and much more! All participants are invited to bring a costume for our costume ball to be held on Sunday afternoon. Prizes will be awarded in several different categories for both youth and adults. Cub Scouts will have the opportunity to earn four belt loops as part of the weekend's activities: BB gun shooting, archery, wildlife conservation, and ultimate. Siblings will participate in all activities except for BB guns and archery. During this time siblings will be making a marshmallow shooter so they can take a "shot" at hitting the bull's-eye along with their brothers! The fee for this year's event will be \$55 per Cub Scout and siblings and \$35 per adult if registered prior to October 3rd. Registrations received after October 3rd are subject to a \$10 late fee per participant. Registration fees will include all meals (dinner Friday not provided), glow-in-the-dark RFSR plastic mug, patch, and all program materials needed for the weekend.
